When packing, consider the location to where you will be traveling and be sure you have appropriate clothing. Many locations can have widely varying temperatures, especially if you'll experience significant altitude changes.

Although Corbell Photographic Workshops generally don't involve any significant or strenuous hikes, you should have good walking/hiking shoes. Many of the areas in which we will photograph can have uneven, rocky, slippery or wet surfaces.

We may be spending many hours out in remote areas with limited facilities. I would recommend that you plan on bringing drinking water and snacks.

Traveling Internationally

International travel requirements vary greatly depending upon your destination. Be sure to check with your travel agent or airline about specific requirements. Ensure your immunizations are up to date. You must have a valid passport and, depending upon the destination, a valid visa.

 Verify travel document requirements well in advance
- Notify Bank/Credit Card companies that you will be traveling and where.
- Foreign currency most time you can easily obtain currency upon your arrival but check on this before you leave.
- □ ATM Card Notify bank that it will be used in a foreign country.
- □ Adapters &/or Transformers for foreign power
